

Upgrade Guide 1.x.x to 2.x.x

Lorem

Ipsum sit amet *em dolore*. :::Starting from **blogr v2.0.0**, the package requires **Laravel 13** and **FilamentPHP v5**.

If your application is still on Laravel 12 / Filament v4, you must update it **before** upgrading blogr.

Why a major dependency shift?

Requirement	blogr ≤ v1.32.x	blogr ≥ v2.0.0
Laravel	12.x	13.x
Filament	v4.8.5	v5.0
Livewire	3.x	4.x
PHP	8.3+	8.3+ (unchanged)

These changes are transitive: you cannot keep Laravel 12 or Filament v4 and upgrade blogr.

Step-by-step upgrade

1 — Update dependencies (one command, no manual editing)

```
# Core + plugins + Laravel + Filament – all in one go
```

```
composer require \  
  laravel/framework:^13.0 \  
  laravel/tinker:^3.0 \  
  filament/filament:^5.0 \  
  happytodev/blogr:^2.0 \  
  happytodev/blogr-comments:^2.0 \  
  happytodev/blogr-gdpr:^2.0 \  
  happytodev/blogr-artist:^2.0 \  
  happytodev/blogr-docs:^2.0 \  
  spatie/laravel-backup:^10.0 \  
  -W --no-update
```

```
# Then run the actual update
```

```
composer update -W
```

If you prefer to edit `composer.json` manually, here are the diff:

```
"require": {  
-   "laravel/framework": "^12.0",  
+   "laravel/framework": "^13.0",  
  
-   "laravel/tinker": "^2.10",  
+   "laravel/tinker": "^3.0",  
  
-   "filament/filament": "^4.2",  
+   "filament/filament": "^5.0",  
  
-   "happytodev/blogr": "^1.32",  
+   "happytodev/blogr": "^2.0",  
  
-   "happytodev/blogr-comments": "^1.1",  
+   "happytodev/blogr-comments": "^2.0",  
  
-   "happytodev/blogr-gdpr": "^1.5",  
+   "happytodev/blogr-gdpr": "^2.0",  
  
-   "happytodev/blogr-artist": "^1.0",  
+   "happytodev/blogr-artist": "^2.0",  
  
-   "happytodev/blogr-docs": "^1.10",  
+   "happytodev/blogr-docs": "^2.0",  
  
-   "spatie/laravel-backup": "^9.0",  
+   "spatie/laravel-backup": "^10.0",  
}
```

2 — Verify your `bootstrap/app.php`

Laravel 13 renamed `ValidateCsrfToken` to `PreventRequestForgery`.

If your application references it, update the import:

```
- use Illuminate\Foundation\Http\Middleware\ValidateCsrfToken;  
+ use Illuminate\Foundation\Http\Middleware\PreventRequestForgery;
```

3 — Run your test suite

```
php artisan test  
# or  
vendor/bin/pest --parallel
```

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4. Run your test suite

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php artisan test  
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vendor/bin/pest --parallel
```

Known breaking changes in the dependency chain

Laravel 12 → 13

- `VerifyCsrfToken` / `ValidateCsrfToken` → renamed to `PreventRequestForgery` (deprecated aliases still work for now)
- `JobAttempted` event: `$exceptionOccurred` (bool) replaced by `$exception` (object or null)

- **QueueBusy event:** `$connection` renamed to `$connectionName`
- **Container::call:** Now respects nullable class defaults (returns `null` instead of resolving)
- **JSON encoding:** `Http::response()` with array body now throws on invalid UTF-8

Filament v4 → v5

- **Livewire v4:** `Livewire\Mechanisms\ComponentRegistry` removed — use `Str::kebab(class_basename())` for component name resolution
- **Filament\Support\Icons\Heroicon enum** → replaced by plain string icons (`'heroicon-o-folder'` instead of `Heroicon::OutlinedFolder`)
- **PanelProvider methods:** `static function panel()` → `function panel()` (instance method)

spatie/laravel-permission v6 → v8

Rollback

Happytodev

If the upgrade fails, restore your previous `composer.json` and `composer.lock` :

```
git checkout -- composer.json composer.lock
composer install
```

Then fix any issues and retry.
